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## **SURVEY INFORMATION & HIGHLIGHTS**

- → Created in response to widespread demand in the absence of reliable information about educators' experience
- $\rightarrow$  Fear of retaliation, isolation
- → Many members want to stay anonymous (half of storytellers requested anonymity)

- Open to all members
- So far, 1,550 responses from

over 120 locals in 3 weeks

 Over 150 stories told on instances of verbal and physical assault as well as various types of threats and harassment
